- 2. It shall be the responsibility of the person in charge of the booking group to ensure all tutors' eligibility to conduct relevant activities.
- 3. In order to avoid any unexpected accident and cost happening, activity organizers shall decide whether to hold or cancel their activities depending on the ability, physical condition, and experience of the participants.
- 4. Applicants should submit completed *the Facilities Booking Form* 3 months prior to the date of use. Application after this deadline will be considered and processed on physical truth.
- 5. It is important for the booking group to check carefully all the facilities once receive it. Any discrepancy or damage should be notified immediately to Camp Staff for follow-up.
- 6. The user shall be responsible for all reinstatement cost of any damage of the premises and facilities caused during the camp period.
- 7. The Camp reserves the rights to immediately terminate the camp period out of security reason, all deposits and payments will not be refunded.
- 8. The Camp reserves the rights to reject any unqualified application.
- 9. Participants should be responsible for their own safety and should follow the instructions from our staff. The Camp is not liable for any loss of personal belongings or harm caused to the participants during the activities.
